Tips & Tricks Stage Your Bed to Sell

Make your master bedroom feel luxurious and easy for the buyers to envision themselves retreating and relaxing there by staging it to impress. If possible, place the bed opposite the door so that it's the first thing the buyers see when entering the room.

- Soften and Layer: Place a new light and neutral blanket or bedspread and tuck
 in the sides, if your bedframe allows it. Fold the duvet into thirds and place at
 the foot of the bed for that sense of comfort and luxury. Place your sleeping
 pillows up against the headboard, followed by the pillow shams that coordinate
 with your duvet. Add 2 or 3 matching feather decorative pillows in front with
 another colour contrasting pillow in the middle.
- 2. **Colour Coordinate:** The bedding and pillows should subtly coordinate with the room's colour scheme. Pick up the colours you see elsewhere in the room such in the curtains, wall colour, area rug, and artwork.
- 3. **Crowning Glory:** If you have a short or nonexistence headboard, you can still make your bed the focal point by hanging scale appropriate artwork above it.
- 4. **Finishing Touches:** If you have a standard bedrail frame, place a tailored bed skirt so that the bed looks finished, and you can conceal items underneath!
